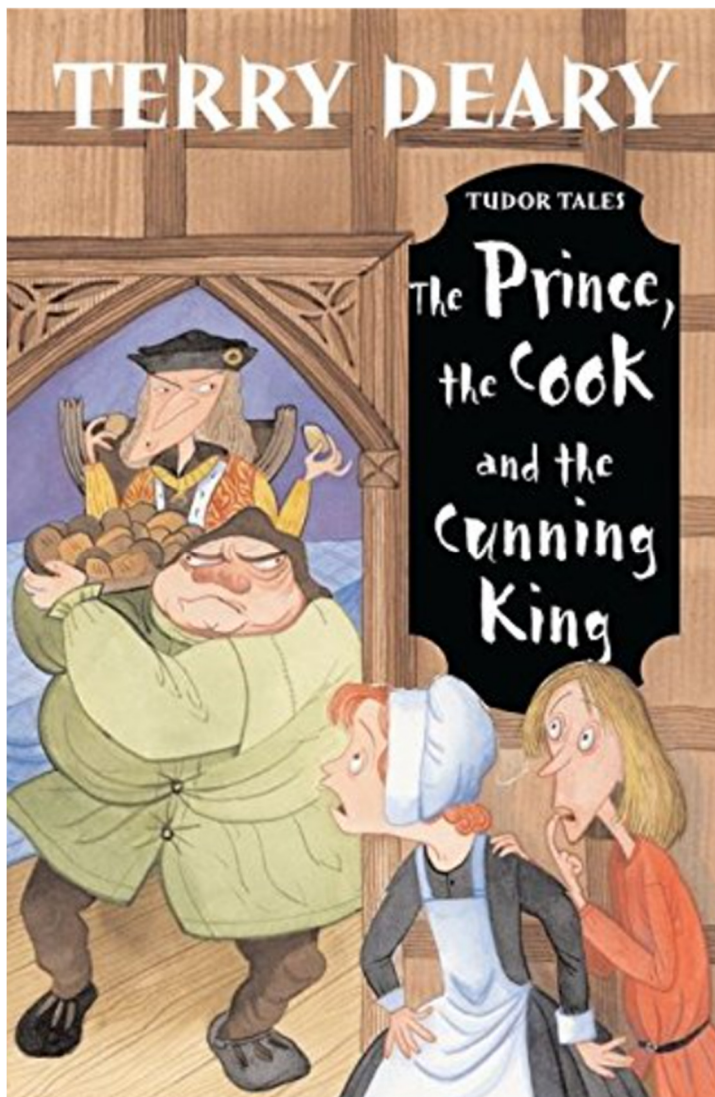

Year 3 - Summer 1 Learning journey



Reading

This term we will be reading a fictional narrative called The Prince, the Cook and the Cunning King by Terry Deary. This links to our Tudor topic. Each week, we will be focusing on different reading strategies to develop our reading skills. Some of the reading strategies we will be focusing on are:

- Predicting
- Questioning
- Making connections
- Clarifying
- Inference
- Summarising



Writing

In writing, pupils will continue to use the 'Write Stuff' approach, to build texts by creating a series of sentences which focus on incorporating different writing skills.

The children will be working on sentence stacking for a narrative based on the story 'The Prince, the Cook and the Cunning King' by Terry Deary which links to their reading text. They will also construct their own non-chronological report, based on our learning about the Tudors in History.

During the last week of each unit, the children will be asked to complete an independent writing task. The children will be focusing on punctuation, speech, fronted adverbials, paragraphs and sentence structures.

Maths

This term we will be focusing on column subtraction and how to set these questions out correctly, regrouping the tens column and using these skills to solve word problems. We will also be focusing on unit fractions, explaining the relation of the part and the whole. Looking closely at the numerators and denominators and how they can and cannot be compared.



Science

This term the children will be learning about Light. The focus of the unit will be how light only travels in straight lines, what light sources are and what are not light sources. The children will learn about how shadows are formed and what happens to the size of a shadow when the object moves closer or further from the light source.



Computing

This term pupils will be building on the use of the 'ScratchJr' application that was introduced in Year 2. They will progress to using the more advanced computer-based application called 'Scratch', learning to use repetition or 'loops' and building upon skills to program; an animation, a story and a game.



History

This term the children will be focusing on learning all about The Tudors. They will be applying their new vocabulary from their English lessons and their reading lessons. We are going to be learning about key historic figures such as King Henry VIII and his wives, Queen Elizabeth I and William Shakespeare whilst looking into key events such as the War of the roses and the Age of Discovery.



Art and Design and Technology

In design and technology, pupils will identify and learn about the key features of a castle, before designing and making a recycled-material castle (structure).



Music

This term in music, pupils will continue to learn to play the violin. They will work on learning pieces and using different skills to create sounds on the violin.



MFL

Throughout this term in French, we will be learning the names of French modes of transport. We will be building sentences to apply this vocabulary.



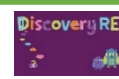
PSHE

This term the children will be looking at how to manage change and we will also be looking into financial capability and how to effectively manage money.



RE

This term's RE topic will be Sikhism, with a specific focus on sharing and community. The key question the children will be asked is; Do Sikhs think it is important to share? Why?



PE

In PE, the children will be focusing on rounders. They will learn different ways to pass a ball to a teammate, how to move around in a game and they will learn how to score a rounder.
