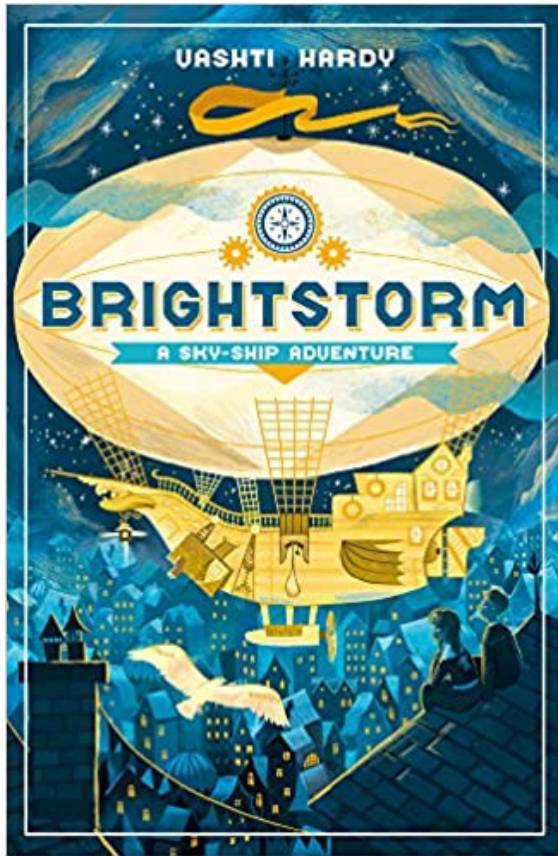




Year 5 – Summer 1 Learning Journey



Reading



This term we will be reading Vashti Hardy's 'Brightstorm: A Sky-Ship Adventure.' It is described as 'a fast-paced fantasy adventure that will set your imagination soaring!'

Twins Arthur and Maudie Brightstorm receive word in Lontown that their famous explorer father has died in a failed attempt to reach the southernmost point in the world. Not only that, but he has been accused of stealing fuel before he died!

The twins don't believe the news, and they answer an ad to join a new attempt to reach South Polaris. It's their only hope of learning the truth ... and salvaging their family's reputation.

Children will participate in daily Destination Reader sessions to develop key reading skills such as inference, summarising and evaluating.

Maths

This term in maths, we will be looking at proper and improper fractions looking at: multiplying, adding, quantity of a fraction, describing and comparing two fractions, equivalent fractions, describing patterns in a number system and fraction to decimal equivalents.

Writing

In these weeks, the children will be learning all about Biography writing as they learn about people's first attempts at taking to the air.

In weeks 4-6 we will be writing a story based on the book we have been reading in destination reader.

In our writing lessons, we follow Jane Considine's 'Write Stuff' approach, where children learn to take the time to consider word choices carefully as they craft varied and interesting sentences, looking at the writing through a range of lenses, such as action, similes, personification and sentence structure.



PE

Our PE focus is Rounders, which will cover the skills of team work, hitting, throwing and catching. Pupils will also aim to develop their flexibility, strength, technique, control and balance.

Science



This term we will be looking at the properties and changes of materials. We will be comparing and grouping everyday materials, exploring solids, liquids and gases, look at how mixtures can be dissolved, separated and recovered, as well as exploring changes that are reversible and irreversible.

Art & Design Technology

As part of our DT unit this term, we will be focussing on healthy eating and following a recipe.



Geography



In geography we will be revisiting longitude and latitude, to build our knowledge of the United Kingdom and the wider world.

Computing



Through our topic of *Computing Systems and Networks: Search Engines*, we will be exploring how a search engine works, understand the importance of keywords in order to search effectively and combine text and images in a poster.

Music



After learning to play the 12 Bar Blue chord sequence, we will learn the blues scale and improvise our own melodies.
